This **two-day** workshop has been designed specifically for people working in our industry and will allow you to achieve the national units of competency, required for sprayers working in nurseries under Queensland WHS law;

AHCCHM304 – Transport & Store Chemicals

AHCCHM307 – Prepare & Apply Chemicals to control pests, weeds and disease

Completion of these two units provides evidence that the participant has the skills to safely mix and apply ag-chemicals as part of their job. The course has been extended to two days to ensure everyone participating achieves the necessary level of competency, even if they are new to the industry. It is not designed as a refresher course for those already performing these tasks.

- Legal requirements in regard to chemicals
- Chemical labels and SDS
- Efficient means of chemical application
- Calibration & maintenance of chemical spraying equipment

This competency-based training will be delivered by a qualified trainer with experience in the Nursery & Garden Industry. Online enrolment plus language, literacy and numeracy short assessment to be completed prior to course, approx. 30 minutes.
