- ✓ Drip irrigation

- ✓ Capillary mat
- ✓ Spray stakes
- ✓ Ebb and flow benches
- ✓ Troughs
- ✓ Inverted overhead sprinklers
- ✓ Upright overhead sprinklers
- ✓ Boom irrigation

At the completion of the nursery tour lunch will be provided along with an opportunity to discuss the different systems further. There will also be printed material made available on the day so you can follow-up on the technical information for each system type.
