# Building capacity in plant protection – Integrated Pest Management

## TUESDAY 18 JUNE 2019



*In collaboration with NGIQ, the Queensland Department of Agriculture (DAF) will deliver a workshop on how to prevent pests from damaging crop using IPM. This workshop is funded by the nursery levy, DAF and Hort. Innovation.*

DAF entomologists and pathologists will present an informative workshop designed for production nurseries to assist nursery producers build capacity in the area of integrated pest management (IPM). A range of topics will be covered, including:

- using IPM to protect plants from key pests
- how to modify crop production to reduce pest pressure
- how to use pesticides within an IPM program
- the physiology behind pesticide mode of action

- how to effectively manage pesticides to reduce resistance
- new biological control agents for production nurseries
- how to identify key pests and beneficials
- getting the most out of industry resources, e.g. the nursery FMS
